Terms and Conditions for Pre-paid Franchise Booking Agents

- (i) The Franchisee holder has to sign an agreement with the Corporation for Pre-paid Agency Booking.
- (ii) The franchise holder shall have its own computer.
- (iii) The franchise holder has to make its own provision for space/shed to open the franchise.
- (iv) The franchise holder is not required to deposit any security amount.
- (v) The franchise holder has to deposit a pre-paid amount for Rs.20,000/- or more as transaction amount with reorder level Rs. 5,000/- which will be the limit for his booking. Once the limit is exhausted his access to the system to book tickets will be stop and he has to recharge his account for further booking with minimum of Rs.10, 000/-.
- (vi) Ticket stocks will be issued by the Corporation to the franchise holder on payment basis @0.10 paisa per ticket.
- (vii) If an agent is having Invoice Issuing Agency (post paid) and wants prepaid agency he has to sign a separate agreement for the same and vice-versa.
- (viii) A prepaid agent would not Issue Invoice to the conductor.
- (ix) There will be no distance bar between the pre-paid agency booking counters at a particular place. But sufficient distance should be maintained from the OSRTC booking counter.
- (x) The franchise holder will get Rs.5/- per ticket as commission which will be printed on the ticket and collected from the passengers at the time of booking. In no case he is allowed to collect extra amount other than that is printed on the ticket. Complains received for collection of extra amount will be seriously dealt with and causing cancellation of the agency.
